In every new issue of News Brake Newsletters Eraps resident Surgeon will help answer any questions you have and help solve a wide variety of Brake related problems.

Q: "I have a Citroën Xantia 1.9 TD and I have tried almost all the different makes of brake pads on the market, but all of them squeak What is the problem?".

A: The problem of squealing brake pads may be caused by the pads fitting badly with the disc. This makes the pads vibrate and produce a squeaking sound. But even when the discs and pads are new, if the assembly is not correctly carried out, it can cause squeaky brakes. The solution to the problem of squeaking brakes is to make sure that the assembly has been carried out correctly and to check that the pads wear in well over the first 300kms or so. You should not brake sharply but try to brake progressively and softly. The noise problem is often associated with the design of the vehicle. There may be materials used in other systems within the car whose vibration frequency coincides with the frequency at which the brake pads vibrate on the calliper when the brake is applied and the noise is produced for this reason. Horsepower pads come standard with anti squeal shims, this will reduce the noise of the pads.
